

Call for Work – *All Art Arizona* - Submission Guidelines

Art Intersection invites artists to submit artwork for consideration in All Art Arizona, a celebration of work created by Artists living in Arizona

Art Intersection celebrates Arizona art with this juried exhibition of work from Arizona artists. This highly acclaimed eight-week exhibition offers the opportunity for visual artists of all experience levels to bring their work before a public audience.

The range of work acceptable for submission includes sculpture, glass, photography, painting, ceramics, wood, printmaking, mixed media, artist books, and more.

About Art Intersection

Through our staff and facility, we promote the mission to *Learn – Create – Exhibit* as we embrace the intersection of photography with related art forms.

Wood floors, brick walls, and metal ceilings blend to create an inviting environment welcoming visitors to enjoy exhibitions in the Galleries at Art Intersection. The *Exhibit* space at Art Intersection serves to support the gathering of collectors, artists, and art enthusiasts for exhibitions, lectures, seminars, and meetings.

Our Photographic Arts Lab offers a fully outfitted darkroom and digital facility for the beginning, amateur, and professional photographer to engage in the art of photography. This is the *Learn* and *Create* space at Art Intersection.

Submission of Work

Please carefully read this document and the Artist Exhibition Agreement before submitting your Work to *All Art Arizona*, as this will ensure the highest quality results as you prepare to complete the online Application.

Submitting

- Go to the Home or Events Page at artintersection.com and select the “Call for Work – *All Art Arizona*” event to find:
 - Submission Guidelines (this document)
 - Exhibition Agreement
 - Submission Application
 - Payment information
- Artist(s) must be at least 18 years old and a resident of Arizona for at least four months per year
- The \$40 fee pays for up to four (4) works, and must be paid before submissions are accepted
- The registration fee may be paid:
 - In-person by check, cash, credit card, or Apple Pay
 - Online using a credit card, debit card, or PayPal
- Only original Work is eligible for the exhibition
 - Art Intersection will decide the final eligibility of submitted Work
 - Work(s) previously exhibited at Art Intersection are not eligible
 - Reproductions are not eligible, e.g. digital prints of oil paintings
- All Work must be ready to install
 - If you have any special installation requirements, please obtain approval in advance
 - To display three-dimensional Work, we have several pedestals, 24”W x 24”L x 36”H
 - Once accepted, please include special instructions for displaying your Work

Call for Work – *All Art Arizona* - Submission Guidelines

- The Work submitted must be the creation of the submitting artist(s)
 - Submission of collaborative work is encouraged
- The online Submission Form requires:
 - Artist name
 - Artwork title
 - Bio / Artist Statement
 - Brief description of the Work
 - Work dimensions
 - JPEG images sized on the short side to 5-inches at 300dpi **and less than 2 Mbytes**
 - JPEG file titles must be saved in the format:
 - "Lastname_Firstname_Submission#.jpg" For example, Smith_Jane_1.jpg.

Important 2018 *All Art Arizona* Dates

- April 11: Submissions due online by midnight MST-AZ
- April 25: Email notification of artists selected for exhibition
- May 23: Deliver selected work ready to install
- June 9: Opening reception, 5 – 8pm
- June 5 – July 28: Exhibition dates
- August 2 - 4: Work available for pickup
- August 25: Work not shipped or picked up is considered abandoned

Exhibiting Information

- **Delivery** - Artists selected for exhibition must be able to deliver Work in person, or ship the Work in a REUSABLE container to arrive by the due date
 - Work that does not arrive by the due date may not be included in the exhibition
 - All packaging must be reusable for return shipping
 - There will be a charge for any packaging supplied by Art Intersection
- **Return** - The artist is responsible for pickup or return shipment of Work that is not sold
 - Provide an electronic, prepaid barcoded, return label for USPS, FedEx, or UPS
 - We do not accept postage stamps for return shipping
- **Sale of Work** - All Work must be for sale
 - See the Artist Exhibition Agreement for more details
- **Labeling** - All delivered Work must be labeled for identification on the backside of the Work
 - Artist Name and Title
 - Art Intersection will make the wall labels based on the submission form
- **Use of Work** - Art Intersection reserves the right to use images of submitted works in social media marketing, on our website, in our printed marketing materials, and other promotional materials.
- **Acceptance** - Submission of your Application indicates acceptance of all terms and conditions of this **Call for Work *All Art Arizona* Submission Guidelines** and the **Artist Exhibition Agreement**.
